### **Mission of the Month - Gary & Rachel de Leon**

Gary and Rachel live in Guatemala and work within the ministry of AMG (Advancing the Ministries of the Gospel). One of their main focuses of ministry is a program Gary directs called COLOCA, which is a job placement opportunity for youth from at risk communities. It's well known in Guatemala City that if you live in a slum community you are less likely to be hired since slums are associated with gangs and violence. You are also not obligated to attend school after 6th grade. So with the lack of job opportunities, there is also a lack of motivation to earn a degree which contributes to the rise of poverty, uneducated youth, gang and drug involvement, early teen pregnancy, etc. The COLOCA program helps provide for their physical and social needs, so then a focus can also be placed on their spiritual needs. Their hope is once they graduate they have the skills and tools to find a job and provide for their family. Our offering for Gary & Rachel will be received on May 21.
