An update from the de Leon's, our mission of the month for April. Please pray for their needs and consider supporting them through the offering plate or the church website.

Thank you Fourth family for partnering with our family and ministry all these years especially during this pandemic! We truly feel blessed and loved by all of you even from afar! We opened TAVA programs up again in February 2021 after 11 months of being closed down because of the pandemic. The programs offered to kids and teens are: after school tutoring, Bible lessons, nutrition, computer class, English as a second language, reading and soon sports and a community garden. TAVA first began to serve families displaced by a volcano eruption that happened in 2018. Since then 8 more communities have been added - displaced by natural disasters (volcano eruption and floods). Our roles have also branched out to providing immediate relief to major natural disasters in Guatemala by providing aid thru food baskets, health kits and rebuilding homes. We've been busy despite the year of lockdown. Pray for our family as we face this new year of programs at TAVA. For the kids and teens to be committed to the program and for unity among them. For our kids beginning school this year. Xavi is finishing pre-k this semester and Iker will start pre-k in the next one at a Christian American school near our home. Pray for this transition for them and for those added expenses that God will provide for. Praise that we have been healthy and safe during the pandemic while still serving in the community.
