## Sermon Notes:

Part of Israel's liturgy, Psalm 51 unpacks David's response to the prophet Nathan, when David was indicted for his conniving, sinful behavior toward Bathsheba and her husband, Uriah. This Psalm exposes David, a hero of our faith, as deeply flawed and broken. We can learn a few things about repentance from these ancient words from David.

1. David reacts with \_\_\_\_\_.

*"...you are right in your verdict and justified when you judge."*

*"...transgressions...iniquity...sin...crushed...guilt..."*
