Missionaries of the Month: Mission India

Mission India's Adult Literacy Class runs for 2 hours per night, five nights a week, for one year. In addition to teaching Bible-based reading, writing, and math up to a 5th grade level, the holistic curriculum offers programs focused on health and hygiene, income generation and entrepreneurship, and social issues. Students also hear the Gospel – many for the first time. On average, two-thirds of classes grow into churches! \$6,000 sponsors one project of five literacy classes, providing Bible-based literacy to 150 illiterate adults! Donations for Mission India can be given anytime during the month of February.
