Missionaries of the Month: Words of Hope

This month we are featuring Words of Hope as our mission! We are focused on raising funds to support the Kuku New Testament translation project for Uganda. The Kuku tribe is the home tribe for Words of Hope Uganda Director, Titus Baraka. WOH became aware in the past few years of an effort in Uganda to translate the Bible into more heart languages – including Kuku. They know the gospel because of Words of Hope radio programs, but they lack their own Bible and this is something they desperately want to have. Despite the challenges this community faces, their leaders have committed to raising 15% of the cost of the translation themselves. The goal is to raise \$10 per verse for all 7,957 New Testament verses! Thank you for supporting this project for the people of Uganda! You can give at the end of today's service.
