Youth with a Mission, Bangkok Thailand: equipping, sending out and supporting more Thai nationals in Kingdom ministry. One ministry focus this year is to mobilize Thai missionaries into remote villages. Jeff's role is to support his partner Paw Pan as he runs the university student ministry and upcountry activity centers under the Taw Sang Rak Foundation, mobilizing Thai youth into ministry. Jeff consults with Paw Pan on strategy, helps raise funds and reports to the Thai government. Young people typically start as students at the university and some go on to a Discipleship Training School before becoming volunteer ministry staff.
