Free Foundry Learning Opportunity! You're invited to join others from the Michigan Catalyst Network and The FoundryGR for our class session in our Distinctives of Reformed Theology course from 12pm-3pm on Tuesday, September 17, at Community Reformed Church in Zeeland.
