## Free Foundry Learning Opportunity!

You're invited to join others from the Michigan Catalyst Network and The FoundryGR for our class session in our Distinctives of Reformed Theology course from 12pm-3pm on Tuesday, September 17, at Community Reformed Church in Zeeland. During that time together, we will be focusing on Ecclesiology, the study of the Church. We'll interact with each other about how we even use that term, "church," in so many different ways. We'll be discussing the attributes of the church as One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic, how those relate to what the Reformed tradition refers to as the "marks" of the church: preaching, discipline, and the sacraments. And in this session, we will take a deeper look at the sacraments, especially the Reformed view on baptism and the Lord's Supper or Communion. Along the way with all these, we will be engaging what the Belgic Confession and Heidelberg Catechism have to say on each of these and looking more closely at numerous scripture passages that teach these views.
