Missionaries of the Month: De León Family

Hello from Spain! We are praying for some much needed rest over the holidays. We've been going full speed since September and life hasn't slowed down. Looking forward to the holidays and spending time with family. In early November, we had two weeks of intense rain. These heavy rains, called DANA, devastated many small towns in southern Spain. Homes were lost and unfortunately people's lives as well. As soon as we saw the damages, Gary set up a group of volunteers to help clean up and restore their homes! Word spread quickly, and at one point, we had 60 volunteers arrive with shovels, buckets, and trucks full of donations. A company even sent six excavators to help remove the mud. Over three weekends, this group of volunteers helped three communities and many families. It was such a big impact to see Spaniards coming together! Donations for the De León family can be given anytime during the month of December.
